RECOGNITION

AIM

SZABIST in collaboration with Earthquake Recovery and Rehabilitation Authority (ERRA) is launching Diploma in Disaster Risk Management. The Diploma aims at developing requisite capacity building of professionals and individuals to analyze, plan, implement, and monitor plans and procedures to mitigate the effects of Disaster.

OBJECTIVE OF THE DIPLOMA

- a. Develop an understanding of the disaster, multifaceted effects of disaster, and response to disaster through prevention, mitigation, recovery, and rehabilitation.
- b. Develop requisite competence to effectively plan, implement, monitor and evaluate disaster risk management plan.
- c. Critically analyze the contemporary disaster risk management perspectives and draw appropriate lessons to make own response more efficient and effective.
- d. Understand and develop integrated mechanism for an effective response strategy based on public and private partnership.
- e. Develop organizational competence to effectively respond to disasters.

ADMISSION CRITERIA

The candidate should be minimum Graduate (minimum fourteen years of education in any discipline).

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

- Representatives of profit and nonprofit organizations, students, potential volunteers to work in disaster related fields, and representative of general public.
- 3 x credit hours shall be transferable to normal academic programs in SZABIST for all students undertaking this course.

FEES

- a. Registration Fee: Rs: 10,000/00
- b. Tuition Fee: Rs: 28,500/00 (Diploma), and Rs: 14250/00 (Certificate)
- c. Discount of 5% shall be provided in case of five or more nominations from organization and for SZABIST alumni/students.

DURATION OF THE DIPLOMA COURSE

The duration of the course shall be 4 months (16 weeks) based on 96 contact hours. There will be two classes of 3 hours each. The days and timings are flexible, weekends/weekdays. The admission shall take place thrice a year.


